The Tunnel – Part of our History

Underground tunnels once connected our hotel with other area businesses on the other side of Main and Division Streets. These tunnels were originally part of the Underground Railroad used by slaves escaping from the South. During Prohibition, hotel guests could walk through the tunnels to other businesses where they would drink and gamble the night away. The tunnels were sealed when this hotel was entirely renovated in the mid-1980's.

During more recent years, guests such as Paul Newman, Tom Cruise, Brad Pitt, Styx, Aerosmith, The Oakridge Boys, Trisha Yearwood, Jack Klugman, Gilbert Brown, Alice Cooper, and many other famous people have graced our hotel.
